### Weekly Updates from Departments:

#### Hinesburg Community Police

- **DUI**—On Tuesday, November 20<sup>th</sup>, the Hinesburg Community Police and the Hinesburg Fire Department responded to a call involving a vehicle off the road on Richmond Road near the Sunset Mobile Home Park. The 76-year-old male failed to negotiate a curve and drove over the edge. It was determined that the man was over the legal limit of alcohol and was transported to Fletcher Allen for observation. He will be cited into court for driving under the influence of alcohol.
- **1<sup>st</sup> Snow Storm**—On Monday, November 26<sup>th</sup>, the first snow storm of the season struck the area. As the police radio was being monitored, the State Police, Shelburne PD and Williston PD all responded to numerous vehicle accidents. During this time, the Hinesburg officer is sitting at Vermont Route 116 and Shelburne Falls Road waiting for the inevitable accident call. As what often happens during past winter storms, the accident call never came. Motorists on our roads tend to drive carefully and are attentive to the changing road conditions. Keep up the good work.

#### Hinesburg Fire Department

- **EMS Calls**- During the past two weeks the EMS division responded to 15 calls for service.
- **Fire Calls**-In the past two weeks the Fire division has responded to 9 calls for service, these include 4 vehicle crashes, two of which involved impaired drivers, two CO calls, 1 false alarm, 1 brush fire and 1 mutual aid call to Charlotte.
