Hinesburg Community Police



Upcoming applications for DRB Review:

- Matt Baldwin: (Final Plat Review for a 2-lot Subdivision) – The applicant is requesting final plat review for a 2-lot subdivision in order to create a separate 2-acre lot for the existing house. The remaining 83 acres will continue to be open land. This 85-acre parcel is located at 1931 Baldwin Road in the Agricultural District.
- Andy Burt: (Development on a Private Right-of-Way) – The applicant is requesting approval for Development on a Private Right-of-Way for the purpose of moving the entrance of his current driveway located a 751 Pond Road to a new access point off of White Tail Ridge Road. This property is located in the Rural Residential 1 Zoning District.
- Aubuchon Realty Company, Inc. – (Site Plan Review) ***The applicant has decided to withdraw their application at this time.***
