#### Hinesburg Community Police

- *Criminal DLS* - On Friday, November 23<sup>rd</sup>, an officer made an enforcement stop on a vehicle with an expired registration. It was determined that the male driver had a criminally suspended operator's license as well as several warrants. The operator was taken to the station for processing and then transported to the Chittenden County Correctional Center for booking.
- *Family Fight* - On Friday, November 23<sup>rd</sup>, an officer responded to the village area for a reported family fight between a mother and her son. The son had left the scene and later came home. The mother did not want charges pressed for damage to her vehicle.

### **Town Administrator**

- Vermont Gas – Met with representatives this past week regarding Vermont Gas Systems Addison Natural Gas Pipeline. Specifically, we discussed their route as it pertains to Geprags Park. Their plans have shifted somewhat from their original proposal. VGS is tentatively scheduled for the December 16<sup>th</sup> Selectboard meeting to discuss the pipeline and how it might impact Geprags. <http://hinesburg.org/vt-gas-project/>
- Public Safety Facility – While construction continues moving forward at a nice rapid pace with the new police station, we are also working to finalize final designs for the proposed fire station additions. By combining the final design work for the fire additions with the work on the police station the Town is benefiting from an overall savings from our architect and engineers. We met over the past week with representatives of VTRANS, CCTA, and the Act 250 Commission to finalize site planning and traffic flow issues. We anticipate bringing the fire addition portion of the project to the DRB within the next six (6) months for permitting. It should be noted that this project is currently unfunded.
