Weekly Updates from Departments:

Hinesburg Community Police

- *Fraud* – We have had several more cases where the IRS have notified residents that someone had already filed tax returns under their names. Unlike a lot of other types of fraud, there is little a person can do to prevent this from happening.
- *Agency Assist* - On Tuesday, April 7th, an officer responded to Huntington to assist the Vermont State Police with a domestic dispute. While en route, it was reported that the individual might be headed to Magee Hill Road in Hinesburg. While waiting in the area, the officer heard that the suspect was on Main Rd. in Huntington. The officer with another VSP trooper responded to the address in Huntington and the suspect was not there. While on Main Rd., the officer observed the suspect vehicle pass by going in the other direction. He radioed the trooper who turned on her blue lights and the subject nearly hit her cruiser. The Hinesburg officer went into a short pursuit which ended when the suspect pulled into a residence. The suspect was ordered to get on the ground and refused to comply with directions. The 42 year old male from Bristol was subsequently taken into custody and arrested by the State Police. Separate charges were filed by the Hinesburg Officer for attempting to elude and resisting arrest.


