Weekly Updates from Departments:

Hinesburg Community Police

• Fatal Accident – On April 26, 2015, at 11:06 a.m., the Hinesburg Police, Fire and First Response responded to what was reported as an auto vs. bicycle accident on Vermont Route 116 south of the village. Upon arrival, it was determined that an automobile had struck a bicyclist. There were bystanders on scene and CPR was in progress on both the driver and the bicyclist. Despite best efforts, both were declared deceased at the scene.

The driver of the vehicle has been identified as seventeen year old Joseph Marshall of Hinesburg.

The bicyclist has been identified as 47 year old Hinesburg resident Richard F. Tom. He was employed by VBT Bicycling and Walking Vacations of Bristol and was less than a half mile from his home when he was struck and killed.

Initial investigation indicates that both vehicles were southbound on Vermont Route 116 and due to excessive speed, Marshall lost control and struck the bicyclist and then a tree. Alcohol or drug use is not suspected.

Agencies responding included Hinesburg Police, Hinesburg Fire, Hinesburg First Response, St. Michaels Rescue, Charlotte Rescue and the Vermont State Police.

- Burglary On Monday, April 20, police were notified of a break in over the weekend to a day care center. A back door was forced open, drawers in several offices were found opened but nothing was found missing.
- Neighbor Dispute On Tuesday, April 21, an officer responded to Wile St. in the Sunset Mobile Home Park for a reported neighbor dispute. Both parties were

separated when police arrived and both parties were contacted and no further action was required.


