#### **Hinesburg Community Police**

- *Stormwater Election Results* - The vote on whether or not to repeal the new storm water regulations approved by the Hinesburg Selectboard on May 18, 2015 was held on July 28, 2015. The question on the ballot was "Shall the changes to the Zoning and Subdivision Regulations, as approved on May 18, 2015 by the Hinesburg Selectboard be repealed?". Those in favor of repealing the storm water regulations received 161 votes and those opposed to repealing the regulations received 266 votes. Therefore, the regulations as approved by the Selectboard were upheld by the voters. There were a total of 427 votes cast which was approximately 12 percent of the total registered voters in Hinesburg.
- *Property Tax Bill* - You should all have received your tax bills in the mail by now. If you didn't receive a copy, please call us and we can send you another one and double-check the address to which it was mailed for accuracy. The residential tax rate increased \$0.0361 cents for a total rate of \$\$2.1550 and the non-residential rate increased \$0.1070 cents to a total of \$2.1858.
