Hinesburg Community Police

- *Community Assistance* - We would like to thank the citizens who have been calling in reports of suspicious persons in their areas. These are the tips that will most likely result in the arrests of our burglar(s).
When you call our phone number, 482-3397, and no one is in the office, it will go to a voice message. If you leave a message, it may be several days before it is returned. Another option is pressing the 1 key which will connect you with Shelburne Dispatch Center. This will connect you with the on duty officer and provide you with immediate service. Finally, when a suspicious person or persons are observed, call as soon as possible so we can attempt to locate the people.
- *Theft* – On Wednesday, August 5th, an officer responded to an address on Upper Access Rd. for a reported theft of a portable generator.
- *Burglary* – On Thursday, August 6th, an officer responded to a burglary report on Richmond Rd.
- *Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol* – On Thursday, August 6th, an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle for a moving violation. It determined that the operator, a 22 year old male from Canterbury, New Hampshire was driving while under the influence of alcohol. He was arrested and taken to the station for processing.
