Thanks to a generous donation from the Bissonette Family of Hinesburg, roughly eleven acres of land have been devoted to the construction of a new recreation facility.


The Plan

- › Two multi-purpose fields suitable for soccer, football, and lacrosse, as well as a regulation size Little League baseball field have been designed and engineered.
- › Parking, restrooms, and a storage/concession building are also planned.
- › Local contractors, vendors, and volunteers are all helping to reduce costs.
- › The Town of Hinesburg has partnered with the CSSU Buccaneers Youth Football Program, the Iroquois Soccer Club and other area athletic clubs to help raise the necessary capital.



Community Benefits

- › A Town owned and managed facility supporting Hinesburg's recreation programs.
- › Consolidation of facilities.
- › Ability to accommodate area athletic clubs such as CSSU Buccaneers Youth Football and Iroquois Soccer.
- › Scheduling flexibility for existing recreation programs and opportunity for expansion.

Costs and Fundraising Goals

The estimated costs assume a fully contracted project. While raising the necessary capital is a priority, in-kind donations of labor and materials will greatly reduce the overall project cost. Our goal is to complete this exciting project without additional funding from tax dollars.

2 Multi-Purpose Fields	\$273,000
1 Little League Baseball Field	\$99,000
Water and Sewer Service	\$62,000
Playground (Tot Lot)	\$15,000
Landscaping	\$40,000
Boundary Survey	\$1,100

Total Projected Cost \$631,100*

* Construction of restrooms, storage space, and concession stand are not included in the estimate.

* Design, permitting, and consultant fees have been funded by the Town of Hinesburg at a cost of \$34,000.
