Dear Neighbor,

As residents of Hinesburg, I appreciate your interest in the Addison Natural Gas Project. Over the past few weeks, there has been much attention focused on this project and I understand that you may have questions as to the proposed pipeline and the possibility of an alternate route.

We have discussed with the Town how best to work with you in a process that is respectful of your time while also allowing for a meaningful exchange of information and dialogue. To that end, we are proposing the following local meetings at the Hinesburg Town Hall to gather your feedback and to discuss the potential for modifications to the proposed pipeline route where possible.

The process would involve two meetings during the month of January:

Wednesday January 9th, 3 pm to 7 pm

- Open House format to review current pipeline route and gather your feedback

Wednesday January 16th, 7:30 pm to 10:00 pm

- Discuss the possibility for pipeline relocation based on your input and other considerations (permitting, constructability, cost, etc.)
- Review the Town's desire for an additional meeting (in late January) to review potential routing modifications, if any, based on your feedback and agency input

I appreciate that your time is valuable but your participation in these meetings is an important part of the process and I encourage your attendance. I will do my level best to ensure that these meetings start and end on time.

Finally, I want to state that Vermont Gas intends to design, build and operate the Addison Natural Gas Project in a manner that is informed by community input, respectful of your concerns and consistent with the state's energy goals.
