General Election Information November 3, 2020

1. Ballots were mailed to all voters who were registered on or before September 2, 2020 by the State of Vermont.
2. Voters who register after that date will be mailed a ballot by the town clerk's office.
3. You may return your ballot by mail or by dropping it off at the town clerk's office located at 10632 Route 116 in Hinesburg. We have a new secure drop box outside our office and you can drop your ballots in there at any time. We will be checking the box several times each day and bringing the voted ballots in to be stored in the vault.
4. Please be sure to read the directions carefully. You need not vote in every race. You **MUST** print and sign your name on the voted ballot envelope and place your voted ballot inside. Otherwise, your vote will not count! If you make a mistake on the ballot while voting at home, you may bring it to the clerk's office for a replacement ballot. Once we have received a ballot through the mail or have put it into secure storage, you may not take it back for revision.
5. If you did not receive a ballot, please call us at 802-482-2281 x1 during our regular hours of Monday-Friday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. and we will be happy to assist you.
6. You may vote in person at the clerk's office between now and November 3rd. The polls will be open from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. on Tuesday, November 3rd as usual. We truly appreciate everyone's efforts to vote ahead of time in order to reduce the risks of Covid-19 for voters, poll workers and staff. It is also helpful if you return your voted ballot to us prior to Election Day. Thank you and be safe!
