Reports

- *Greenspace and Cultural Resources Plan. We have hired a consultant to assist the Commission with this plan using grant funds secured by the Planning & Zoning office. Based on proposals and meetings last week with candidate firms, we chose the proposing team of LandWorks and Woodlot Associates, Inc. to work with based on their extensive planning experience. A formal kickoff meeting will be held June 25, in the downstairs conference room between the PC, HCC, and LandWorks, Inc. to initiate the process. Discussion focused on expectations and the proposed agenda for the kickoff meeting.*
- *Geprags Park. Melissa summarized the success of the site preparation on May 19 for the wind turbine to be installed in Geprags Park and agreed to find out from Rocky when installation of the tower is scheduled. Also, there was discussion of getting the lettering on the park sign repainted and other minor trail work.*
- *New /parallel activities. There was a discussion of educational activities the Commission could be taking on that could parallel the work on the GCRP. One thought was to work with Karen Cornish to make the Commission website more interactive and educational.*
- *Quackenbush/Hoke subdivision –discussion focused on how to respond to this application. Bill and Dave will take the lead in this.*
