Meeting Minutes - February 1, 2017

1. Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.
2. No Additions.
3. Public Comment. None.
4. Quadra Concert follow-up. Next year's concert is tentatively set for 1/5/2018, despite organizers' reluctance in having it so soon after New Year's. Owner of Old Lantern is not available for a later date. Kevin reports they sold about 100 tickets less than previous years, although the event still raised over \$10,000 toward the Bissonette Rec. Field project.
5. Discussion continued about fundraising for the field completion. A Calcutta fundraiser was proposed for later this year or next.
6. Frank explains the Conflict of Interest Policy that the Select Board adopted on 1/9/17.
7. The 2017 Hinesburg July 4th Parade theme is "Mardi Gras". Grand Marshall – Sue Barden who is retiring from her long service at the Carpenter Carse Library.
8. Jen confirms and reminds that the HBPA is the reason that we achieved our goal to purchase our fireworks display by 1/30/17. The HBPA has agreed to host a golf tournament to continue, ongoing fundraising for the fireworks. Kyle suggests that the HBPA is honored or recognized at the start of the fireworks display. Jen agrees to include a "shout out to the HBPA" for all July 4th information for the Rec. Dept. and in the online information.
