Steve,

At last night's meeting (10/15), the Selectboard considered your request to approve the improvements you made to the Weed Road, Shelburne Falls Road intersection. The Selectboard decided that they want to know what the intersection grades and other details actually are before they approve the changes you made. They want you to submit engineering details by a qualified professional for the intersection. Several board members said that they would like the intersection to meet the Town standards, but might be willing to compromise once they have firm intersection details to consider.

I've attached the Town road standards for reference. I recommend having whoever you hire contact either Peter Erb or Mike Anthony to briefly discuss the issues. Preparing a plan to show the intersection details should be straight forward for a qualified professional (e.g., civil engineer). Per the road standards, important elements include: length and grade of paved apron, grade of gravel road approach to the apron, grade and treatment of side slopes/ditches, sight distance to the east and west on Shelburne Falls Road.

Once the intersection details are prepared, please submit them to Joe Colangelo, so that he can have them reviewed by Town staff and then schedule another discussion with the Selectboard.

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
