Dear Mr Colangelo:

At its June 21, 2013 meeting, the Vermont Traffic Committee considered the town's request to establish a No Parking/Loading Zone on VT 116 opposite Mechanicsville Road, and an extension of the 30 mph speed limit northerly 300 ft to accommodate the new on-street parallel parking zone. The Committee approved both requests.

Copies of the official Certificates are included with this letter. The revised speed limit regulation will take effect upon installation of the signs (via the current paving project). The no parking zone is already signed accordingly. No further action is required by the Town, however, we recommend these Certificate copies be filed in the Town records.

CERTIFIED STATEMENT TO ESTABLISH OR CHANGE A SPEED LIMIT ON THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM

In accordance with Title 23, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Section 1003, the following speed limit is hereby designated for the section of State Highway described below:

Route No.: VT 116 Town of: Hinesburg County of: Chittenden

Exact location : A maximum speed limit of 40-mph beginning 0.10± miles south of TH-20 (Buck Hollow Road) (mp 3.85±), extending northerly to 0.15± miles north of TH-20 (mp 4.10±), and then from this point, 30-mph to a point 0.07± miles north of TH-43 (Commerce Street) (mp 5.02±), and then from this point, 40-mph to 0.08± miles north of TH-1 (Shelburne Road) (mp 5.54±).

Also, a school speed limit of 25-mph, when beacons are flashing, beginning 0.28± miles north of TH-20 (Buck Hollow Road)(mp 4.23±), and extending northerly to 0.09± miles south of TH-4 (Silver Street)(mp 4.37±).

This certificate supersedes the speed limits established July 24, 2006 (Cert# 060724-A)


Exact Location of the zone: Parking prohibited except loading or unloading on the west side of
