In my opinion it would be an enforceable ordinance. I see nothing wrong with the exemptions.

I would suggest the following change in Section V., paragraph C.:

C. Town Forest Hunting Exemption – This ordinance shall not apply to hunting in the Town Forest during the annual seasons as defined by the State of Vermont Fishing & Wildlife Department and in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations.

I would suggest the following change in Section VI:

Any law enforcement officer may act as an Issuing Municipal Officer and issue and pursue before the ~~Traffic and Municipal Ordinance~~ Judicial Bureau a municipal complaint for violation of this ordinance.
