

Hinesburg Community Police

Full-Time Police Officer

The Hinesburg Community Police is hiring for a full-time police officer. The Town of Hinesburg is located just 15 minutes from Burlington but maintains a rural character. Officers of this community based organization not only focus on law enforcement but also quality of life issues for its residents. All officers as a condition of employment receive medical training and respond to assist the Hinesburg Fire Department.

The Hinesburg Community Police has an authorized strength of six full time equivalents consisting of five full time, one 32 hour regular part time and three part time officers. Officers are scheduled between 7 am and 11 pm and rotate for on call after hours. The two shifts are assigned based on a rotational signup and this department prides itself on flexible scheduling allowing employees an enhanced home life.

The successful candidate must possess the following minimum requirements: be at least 21 years of age, possess exceptional moral character and ethics, be certified or certifiable as a police officer by the VT Criminal Justice Training Council (VCJTC), must be able to perform all essential functions of the job. Preference will be given to those applicants that are currently certified (full or part time) through the Vermont Criminal Justice Training Council.
