Dear Joe,

The Cemetery commission meet recently and passed the following items. These items will take effect immediately unless we are asked to reconsider any item by the Select board.

1. Lots currently sell for \$300.00 with discounts given for additional purchases example one lot \$300.00, two lots \$500.00, three lots \$700.00. We have increased the price per lot to \$600.00 each and for any additional lot. This increase is after comparing with other towns. We will allow up to four cremations in a single lot. We also plan to allow 4'X4' Lots around the flag pole in the Village Cemetery. These lots will be for cremations only and two per lot will be allowed, all stones in this area will be flush and no flowers or shrubs will be allowed, flowers may be planted around the rocks that surround the flag pole. The price of the flag pole lots will be \$200.00 each.
2. We would like to contract with Wahl's to add new fencing to the Bissonette Cemetery on Gilman Road. This would be a Barb wire fence on three sides and chain link across the front: Cost: barb wire & 1960.00 installed, Chain link \$4,600.00 installed. This will be paid for by funds from our savings account.
3. We have also designated the name "Bissonette Cemetery" to the Gilman Road location.
4. The Bissonette Cemetery will have the following requirements that will be agreed upon at the time of lot purchase.
 - A. All lots will be sold in order starting in the northeast corner and moving south. As many lots as wanted can be purchased but they must be in order. This makes mapping very easy and we do not end up with one lot here and there.
 - B. Corner markers will be installed at time of purchase, this cost will be paid for by the Cemetery commission from the lot sale.
 - C. All Grave Markers will be placed at the direction of the Cemetery Commission.

- D. Any flowers will be planted in front of the stones and the planting area will be no wider than the stone and not more than six inches in depth.
 - E. Up to 4 cremations per lot will be allowed.
 - E. Any other rules as approved by the Cemetery Commission.
5. We are pricing and would like to add small granite signs for each cemetery with the name to identify the location.

Please advise if this had to be presented to the Select board and if I need to be present.
