Joe, please forward to the Select Board prior to the October 21st meeting.

Dear Select Board,

The Creekside Community Association, through its Executive Board, hereby requests closure of most of Farmall Drive and all of Fredric Way on October 31, 2013 between the hours of 6 and 8pm.

As you may or may not know, Creekside has become a Halloween Hot Spot, with some households receiving over 500 trick-or-treaters last year.

We request this closure for Halloween night in an effort to provide a safe environment for the volume of pedestrian traffic we experience.

There should be adequate parking for visitors at Kinney Drugs (recommended), the fire/police station, and Firehouse Plaza (as a last resort).

Police Chief Frank Koss has offered to handle the actual street closure. The streets would be closed at the Farmall Drive stop sign in Creekside so as not to hinder traffic along Farmall Drive and Kaleys Way. To be clear, the portion of Farmall Drive along Hinesburg Center Phase 1 would NOT be closed. Creekside residents, guests of residents, and persons with special needs would be allowed vehicular access.

We intend to advertise such a closure, if approved, with signage and through postings on FPF.
