
At last night's meeting (1/8), the Planning Commission discussed possible projects to propose for the CCRPC UPWP for the coming year. Their highest priority item for additional CCRPC support is stormwater control. Over the last year, they have discussed a three-point plan that the Town should pursue to get a better handle on stormwater control and treatment.

1. **Improved stormwater regulations** – they hope to have a package of regulation changes ready for Selectboard review this spring
2. **Town stormwater infrastructure projects** – both to address problem areas and as demonstration projects
3. **Community outreach & education** – raise awareness, recommend best practices, offer incentives and demonstration projects, encourage residents and businesses to take action on their own property

They feel that the CCRPC has the potential to provide assistance on #3 – i.e., community outreach & education.

Beyond that, the PC also endorsed (with lower priority) the other two project ideas that you suggested in your memo – i.e., municipal water source investigation; Town highway garage site planning. Sounds like we could write up three proposals if the Selectboard is agreeable. I could write up the stormwater project proposal. You could write up the highway garage site plan proposal. Rocky could write up the water source proposal.

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
