Good Afternoon, Trevor,

I'm the Local Emergency Operations Plan point of contact at the Vermont Division of Emergency Management and Homeland Security. As the October 23<sup>rd</sup> Emergency Relief and Assistance Fund (ERAF) deadline approaches, I'm reaching out to towns that are missing their Local Emergency Operations Plan to see if there is any assistance I can provide.

Attached is the Hinesburg ERAF status sheet. As you can see, if a disaster is federally declared on or after October 23<sup>rd</sup>, Hinesburg will only be eligible for 7.5% matching funds from the state of Vermont. If, however, you complete your Local Emergency Operations Plan and adopt the Road and Bridge Standards, Hinesburg will then be eligible for 17.5% matching funds from the state of Vermont.
