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Good morning:

I write again to follow up on your progress with your Local Emergency Operations Plans. As you know, and has been reinforced by the State, these plans were originally due by May 1. Each of you and your communities has worked through various staffing transitions this year, which understandably creates challenges in workflow, timing, and priorities.

However, and as communicated to each of you recently by Emily Harris, the fast-approaching date of October 23 has broader ramifications. If your LEOP is not signed, sealed, and delivered by then, your communities will not be eligible for the higher or highest levels of reimbursement that would be available for damage repair or restoration after a storm or other incident under ERAF rules.

And looking ahead in your own annual work plans, please remember that your LEOP must be updated each year after Town Meeting, and submitted by May 1. This might be as simple as updating key contact personnel after elections or appointment of officers, and/or adding in any new equipment or infrastructure acquired or constructed.

Just wanted to offer these friendly reminders. Enjoy these glorious days of autumn.
