Subject: Selectboard Agenda Item - Road Closure (Farmall Drive/Fredric Way) for Halloween 2014

Hi Trevor, Renae mentioned that you had officially been transitioned into the Town Administrator position, so congratulations!

Please add the following agenda item to an upcoming Select board meeting. I'll be attending the beginning of the meeting on 9/22 if that would be appropriate, but if it's a simple enough matter, it could be brought up tonight without me (the Select board approved this same request last year). Thanks so much!

Dear Select Board,

The Creekside Community Association, through its Executive Board, hereby again requests closure of most of Farmall Drive and all of Fredric Way on October 31, 2014 between the hours of 6 and 8pm.

As you may or may not know, Creekside has become a Halloween Hot Spot, with some households receiving over 500 trick-or-treaters last year.

We request this closure for Halloween night in an effort to provide a safe environment for the volume of pedestrian traffic we experience. To be clear, this is a request to restrict vehicular access, **NOT TO RESTRICT ACCESS TO ANY PERSON OR GROUP.**

There should be adequate parking for visitors at Kinney Drugs (recommended) along Farmall Drive (at Hinesburg Center Phase 1), the fire/police station, and Firehouse Plaza (as a last resort).

Police Chief Frank Koss has agreed to handle the actual street closure. The streets would be closed at the Farmall Drive stop sign in Creekside so as not to hinder traffic along Farmall Drive and Kaleys Way (Kinney Drugs). To be clear, the portion of Farmall Drive along Hinesburg Center Phase 1 would **NOT** be closed.

Creekside residents, guests of residents, and persons with special needs would still be allowed vehicular access.

We intend to advertise such a closure, if approved, with signage and through postings on FPF.
