VTrans Road and Bridge Standards?

Hi Trevor,

Our office is providing VTrans with an update on which municipalities have adopted/plan to adopt the 2013 VTrans Road and Bridge standards. I see that the Town adopted the 2011 VTrans standards (<http://www.hinesburg.org/minutes/minutes11/sb11-0502.html>) - Does the Town plan on adopting the 2013 codes and standards?

Here's why I ask, as per VTrans guidance:

- Remind towns they need to adopt the 2013 VTRB in order to be eligible for the lower local match for the next round of the VTrans Town Highway Structures and Town Highway Class 2 Roadway grant programs (reduced local match also requires completion of a highway infrastructure study as described in the VTrans Orange Book). To be eligible for the lower local match, a certification of adoption must be in place for projects starting after July 1, 2014.

This is still outside of my knowledge area but basically "*adoption of the 2013 VT Town Road and Bridge Standards is necessary to be eligible for reduced local match for the Town Highway Structures Program and the Town Highway Class 2 Program.*"
