Dear Neighbor:

I am writing to inform you of recent developments regarding the Addison Natural Gas Project.

As part of the permitting process, Vermont Gas applied for a Certificate of Public Good from the Vermont Public Service Board (PSB) on December 20, 2012. As your property adjoined the pipeline route, you received a letter at that time informing you of the filing and explaining the general permitting process.

Following the December application to the PSB, Vermont Gas has been in discussion with communities along the pipeline route. As a result of these discussions, the pipeline route has been refined in certain locations and today Vermont Gas has filed with the PSB a revision to its Certificate of Public Good application.

With these refinements, your property as recently identified on the town's certified grand list, still adjoins the refined pipeline route. Accordingly, your rights under the PSB process have not changed and you are welcome to participate in this project as you see fit.
