



**NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING
WATER SUPPLY AND TREATMENT BOND VOTE**

**TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4TH, 2014
7:00 A.M. TO 7:00 P.M.
MAIN HALL, HINESBURG TOWN HALL**

The Town of Hinesburg will hold a vote on a proposed \$1.5 million bond for the acquisition of two new wells, construction of the necessary water supply and treatment infrastructure, and connection to the existing water distribution system. The vote will be held by Australian ballot on November 4th, 2014 in the Main Hall of the Hinesburg Town Hall (10632 Vermont Route 116). Polls will be open from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

The question before voters is as follows:

ARTICLE I. Shall bonds of the Town of Hinesburg, in an amount not to exceed One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000), be issued under subchapter 2 of Chapter 53 of Title 24, Vermont Statutes Annotated, in an amount, payable only by net revenues derived from the municipal water system, for acquisition of two new wells, construction of necessary related infrastructure, and connection to the distribution system?

The two new wells are located on the Wainer property off of Shelburne Falls Road, and would replace the existing wells as the primary water supply for water system users in the village area.
